GLOSSAR

Bachelor-Colloquium

The Bachelor's colloquium is an event that only takes place once per semester (indicated in the semester calendar) and must be attended by students registered for the examination.

Documentation & Presentation

At various points in your degree programme, the department requires you to document your work. You can find instructions for proper documentation in our Notion document (linked via incom). The presentation part of this module refers to the semester

presentations (always after the mid-term and at the end) as well as the presentation of your final theses.

Design Tools

This module is usually offered by the artistic staff and the tutors. They take place on 2-3 Tuesdays in the semester. You will usually be informed about the selection and dates via Incom.

Subject-specific basics

The subject-specific foundations take place in the 2nd and 3rd semesters and serve as preparation for the main degree programme. Here you will get to know basic project work and the professors in the subject area.

Compact design

The two compact design courses traditionally take place in Sauen (→ <https://kh-berlin.de/hochschule/standorte/begegnungsstaette-sauen>), where you will work on a small design project in a large group for a week at the beginning of the summer semester. There are also other opportunities to acquire these certificates from time to time. Information on this will appear in the semester in-com workspace.

Art and Design Basics

Internship

The internship can be applied for as a compulsory internship if this is desired or required for the internship contract. Please contact the person responsible for examination matters in the department.

In depth-courses

These modules are offered within the semester projects by the responsible professors and are therefore automatically part of the semester project.

Practice

The modules in the area of practice are assigned to the → Theory subject area. However, the module 'Sprechen Über' currently has a sister project 'Jitsi Bitsi Spider', which can also be attended as a lecture series and receives the credits from 'Talking about' if attended 4 times in 2 semesters.

Theory & History

Semester project

A semester project is a more complex project that extends over an entire semester. These are usually offered by the professors in the subject area. In a main degree programme, you must complete at least 4 semester projects plus 4 → In depth-courses and 3 → Design Tools.

! It is also possible to choose a semester project with your own topic, but at least 3 people must design a project themselves and register with a professor of their choice 2 months before the start of the semester.
